#### What to You Will Need At Home:

- In-Home WiFi- remote learning requires access to the internet. If you are in need of

- Web-Accessible Device- all students need regular access to a computer, laptop, or tablet. - A Designated Learning Space-students will be able to focus and learn best in an
  area of your home that is clean and free of distractions such as television, video
  games, and maybe even other humans. Establishing learning and working hours
  during the day and maintaining a daily routine such as waking up at the same time,

eating at the same time, and taking breaks at the same time will help to create a sense of normalcy for you and your student.

### What You Can Expect on a Daily Basis:

- Student Engagement- similar to monitoring attendance, the school will be tracking daily participation and expect meaningful engagement from every student. Your student will receive a morning email from an Advisor and should respond letting them know they are online and ready to learn. If we do not receive an email or observe active engagement with daily assignments, this will count as no engagement and we will reach out to find out why, just as we would in the event your student is absent from school.
- Daily Lessons and Assignments- All students should be working on assignments and lessons daily. A schedule for the daily flow of each class is as follows:
